Celebrated the world over for its fabulous architecture, Barcelona is yours to enjoy as your coach first takes you around the city's main sights on this all-day Catalan experience. The route will take you down Passeig de Gràcia, one of Barcelona's main boulevards, passing by Gaudí's unfinished masterpiece, the incredible Sagrada Família. Leaving the breathtaking basilica behind, a location of equally awe-inspiring proportions is next: the jagged sandstone columns of the Montserrat Mountains and the abbey of Santa Maria de Montserrat, an impressive complex of buildings that affords glorious views of the countryside below. A key Catholic pilgrimage site and popular as a religious retreat, the abbey not only hosts a statue of the Virgin of Montserrat, aka the Black Madonna, but also a basilica with an ornately decorated interior. Some time to soak up the beguiling surroundings and have lunch on your own then follows, after which your travels continue by coach to the village of Sant Sadurni and the Cavas Vilarnau wine cellars. Apart from a chance to see how wine, sparkling wine and the bottle-fermented Spanish cava are made, you will also be able to please your palate during the tasting session that concludes your visit. The relaxing return drive to your ship brings your Catalonian outing to a close. Please note: the guide will give explanation only outside the Monastery; guests will visit the site individually and are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits. This excursion is unsuitable for quests with walking



Combine a pleasant walk in the fresh air with an exploration of some of Barcelona's most notable sights in the city centre with some opportunities to buy some local products. Begin with a short coach ride from the port to the first landmark being the Columbus Monument at the lower end of La Rambla avenue. Follow your guide on a pleasant walk down La Rambla en route to Barcelona's Barri Gòtic and the Neoclassical town hall at Plaça Sant Jaume. Next up are outside views of the Gothic Cathedral of Santa Eulàlia - Barcelona Cathedral - and information on this key site. Last on your walking itinerary is Plaça de Catalunya in the middle of town. And after admiring some of Barcelona's landmarks, you will have the opportunity to shop with your guide and discover some classic local products including the famous turrón and the Spanish jamón. A first stop will be at El Taller de Virginia, a local turrones and chocolate shop, founded almost 100 years ago and still producing some of the best sweet delicacies. Your guide will help you choosing the perfect gift for yourself or for friends and family. Then, stop at Enrique Tomas' shop, a company with 40 years of experience offering only the best Spanish jamones. The products are sold vacuum-packed, can be purchased, and taken on the ship. And to tempt you even more, there will be tastings in both shops. Afterwards, you will have free time to shop on your own; your guide will give you some tips on where to have a good memory of Barcelona. The tour ends at Plaza Cataluña and you can choose to remain in the city and make your way back to the port later or reach the place where the shuttle bus will transfer you to the port. Please note: this tour is unsuitable for guests with walking difficulties as it includes long periods of walking. Guests will use the shuttle service to reach the starting point of the tour. Guests with any type of food intolerance are required to communicate it to the Shore Excursions Office at least two days before the call.








Do not miss your chance to immerse yourself in the fascinating world and works of Barcelona's premiere architect: the world-famous Antoni Gaudí. After leaving the port, your tour will take you down the beautiful Passeig de Gràcia avenue for a drive-by of Casa Batlló, a flamboyant building that is covered in thousands of multi-coloured tiles. Up next is Casa Milà, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, for another drive-by, followed by the Park Güell, a garden complex and one of Barcelona's key tourist attractions due to its remarkable, sinuous buildings, stunning mosaics, and ceramic-covered benches. The excursion also includes time to visit inside Gaudí's unfinished neo-Gothic masterpiece, the Sagrada Família. Your tour ends with a scenic return drive to the port. Please note: Guests using a wheelchair are welcome to participate in this tour but should be aware that it includes long periods of walking, that they must be accompanied by a paying helper to assist with getting on and off the coach, and that wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable, as the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Park Güell is not fully accessible to wheelchair users: there are some stairs at the monumental area where Gaudi's dragon is located that is not wheelchair accessible. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. The visit of the Sagrada Família lasts approx. 30 minutes. Please consider that approx. 30 minutes are spent at checkpoint scanners at the venue; to speed up queues and pass the security, we recommend bringing only a small bag or backpacks. Moreover, as the entrance at the Sagrada Familia is fixed at scheduled times, guests are kindly recommended to be punctual at the meeting points and during any stop throughout the tour. Any delay could reduce the time spent inside the venue. Due to traffic restrictions around the area of the Sagrada Familía, the bus will stop close by and quests must walk approx. 10/15 minutes. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits. We suggest wearing comfortable shoes. Entrance tickets included: Park Güell and Sagrada Família.






Combining the charm of ancient history with the carefree atmosphere of a typical Tunisian village full of charm and colours, this half-day excursion begins by leaving La Goulette, the port of Tunis, and reach Carthage. Enjoy a guided visit fo this important archaeological site, a city from the 6th century B.C. that was once the base of a powerful trading empire. Its most famous citizen was Hannibal, the general who crossed the Alps to do battle with the Romans. You will see the Tophet, a sacred open-air site where sacrifices to the gods were made in the Punic period, and visit the Baths of Antoninus, built in the 2nd century and one of the most important spas in the African provinces of the Empire. It is the highlight of the entire archaeological site of Carthage with its friezes and mosaics of great beauty. Continue to the Roman cisterns, the Cisterns of La Malga, a short distance from the site, declared a UNESCO heritage site and enjoy a brief photo stop. The second part of the excursion changes completely. You will reach to the town of Sid Bou Said, situated on a promontory with beautiful views of the Gulf of Tunis. As you walk with your guide through the cobbled streets of this former fishing village, now a must-see for any visit to Tunis, you will notice that the dominant colours are white and blue. Photography enthusiasts will enjoy capturing characteristic corners and squares during the free time and before boarding the bus to return to the port of Tunis. Please note: the museum visit in Sidi Bou Said is optional and not included in the price; guests must pay the entrance fee if they wish to visit. This tour includes walking on uneven ground in Carthage and on cobblestones and uneven surfaces in Sidi Bou Said. There are 12 steps to reach the Baths of Antoninus. 




Enjoy a day out to discover the beauty of Tunis. A short coach ride from the port will take you to the old medina quarter, which is a UNESCO world heritage site and boasts some 700 monuments, including historical palaces, mosques, mausoleums, and fountains. It is also where spectacular architectural beauty meets a shopper's delight: the typical and traditional spice market with hundreds of stalls selling a huge variety of local produce. After the Medina, you will head to Ksar Saïd Palace, a historical palace located in Bardo, on the outskirts of Tunis. It dates dates to the 19th century and was the residence of the Husainid dynasty Beys. The palace was expanded during the reign of Muhammad III as-Sadiq Bey, where many sections and suites were added to it. Restored in 2019, it was renamed "Ksar Said, Palace of Letters and Arts". Enjoy a guided visit of some of the rooms to admire the most significant displays. Time for a break to taste a delicious lunch before continuing to archaeological site of Carthage, a city from the 6th century B.C. that was once the base of a powerful trading empire. The visit to this UNESCO Heritage Site includes a stop at the sacred Punic Tophet, a spine-tingling open-air memorial to deceased infants from this early Phoenician period, and the Baths of Antoninus, built in the 2nd century, the ruins of the largest Roman bath complex outside Rome itself. Enjoy a 1-hour coach drive to Cefalù, a small yet pretty town situated one hour away from Palermo and which was founded by the Norman King Roger II in the XII century on the site of an earlier historic settlement. You will visit Cefalù Cathedral, the "Duomo del Cristo Pantocratore", an example of Norman-Romaneque architecture with stunning interior Norman-Byzantine mosaics. Next on the list is the visit to the medieval lavatory, a public lavatory where people used to wash their clothes in the Middle Age and fully restored in 1991, a legacy of medieval times, carved into the rock. Enjoy a guided walk along the historical centre and some free time to explore the narrow, atmospheric streets. Quality local craft shops make Cefalù a great place for souvenir shopping. Please note: this tour includes walking on uneven ground and is unsuitable for guests with walking difficulties. If the Cathedral is closed on public holidays or during special events, the visit will be external. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits.





Palermo's Teatro Massimo, the third largest opera house in Europe, is part of this half-day excursion, along with a panoramic tour of the city. The first part of the excursion is dedicated to photography enthusiasts, who will be able to capture the splendid panorama of Palermo from the 610-metre-high Monte Pellegrino. Back in the city, the itinerary includes an overview of Mondello, famous for its beaches, and other short photo stops to capture the beauty of the gulf and then the Casina Cinese and Parco della Favorita. Arriving at the Teatro Massimo, the largest theatre in Italy, you will be fascinated by the structure with its huge dome and the façade that resembles a temple with columns. The tour inside will leave you even more breathless as you pass through the foyer, the hall of mirrors, to the great horseshoe shaped auditorium with 31 boxes including the royal box. Your guide will tell you a few anecdotes about the theatre, which could seat up to 3000 people, before leaving this marvel of opera and continuing the tour with a walk through the streets of Palermo. Follow the guide along Via Maqueda, past the 4 Canti, Piazza Pretoria and admire the Cathedral from the outside. And it is in this setting, comfortably seated in front of Palermo Cathedral, that you will pause to enjoy two Sicilian delicacies, an arancino (fried stuffed rice balls) and a cannolo (a sweet pastry filled with ricotta cheese), accompanied by a glass of passito wine. After some free time, the coach will take you back to the port, passing the monument dedicated to the victims of the Mafia. Please note: This tour includes approximately 1 hour of moderate walking, at times over uneven surfaces. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. 

Take yourself off the ship for a few hours of exploring the beautiful cityscape of Naples by pedelec - an electrically assisted bike - and get a bit of a workout in at the same time. 

After a look at the house of Christopher Columbus, you'll pedal on to Genoa Cathedral, consecrated in 1118, and Piazza de Ferrari for a break. Take some photos of the fine buildings on the square, which is near the 13th-century Doge's Palace. Next, you'll bike your way to the pretty fishing village of Boccadasse, where you can have a break at one of many cafés or go for a swim at the short stretch of beach. On returning to the city, you'll make your way to Via Garibaldi, a UNESCO World Heritage Site as a street of palaces. After a short climb to a viewpoint, you can enjoy final views of Genoa before biking back to the ship. Please note: this tour is only for guests who do not embark/disembark in the port of Genoa. 

GOA19T - BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE AQUARIUM WONDERLIJKE NATUUR Leave the ship for a few hours and instead check yourself in to an educational and family-friendly outing for a behind-the-scenes look at Italy's largest aquarium, the Acquario di Genova. Built to coincide with the Genoa Expo in 1992, which in turn commemorated the 500th anniversary of the New World being discovered by Columbus, the aquarium is home to a vast collection of marine wildlife. After a short ferry transfer to the old part of Genoa and the Acquario, you and your family can first enjoy an unguided visit of the various tanks that provide a habitat for tropical fish, sharks, natural coral, penguins and dolphins. At a prearranged time, you'll then proceed on an expertly guided "behind-the-scenes" tour of the facility, during which you'll get to see the on-site laboratories, maintenance and plankton farming activities as well as how the animals are cared for and reared.
